19th November '21

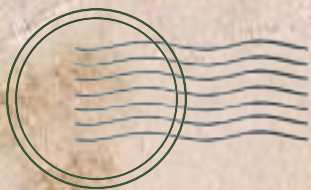




Dear Grandpa and Grandma,
